We are pleased to announce Art Camp is back! Mosaic Connection will once again be conducting a week long kids art camp. Children previously in grades 2nd thru 6th, will enjoy five fun filled days full of arts, music, and theater, while developing new relationships and individual purpose. They will start each day with "meet & greet", devotional time, and one of several art projects ranging from sculpture and clay to chalk art and painting. All led by area artists and Mosaic volunteers. Lunch will be provided by Mosaic volunteers. The days will wind up with group sessions of music, storytelling, or drama activity.

The campers will be divided into two age groups, for the art times, then brought together for afternoon sessions. This will allow us to plan more age appropriate projects for the older kids.

Art Camp will run from July 18-22, 10:00am - 3:00pm, (parent sign-in at 9:45am), with a "Look What I Did" closing reception, July 22, 6:00 - 8:30pm. This is a celebration for the families and friends of the art camp participants to be able to come and see what the children created during the week. Refreshments will be provided.

Wooster Mennonite Church will generously be providing the venue for Mosaic's art camp.

Donations are appreciated but the camp and all materials are provided at no cost by Mosaic Connection to only 36 children. Pre-registration is required and selection will be made on a first come first serve basis.
